

The Background

In 2015, COSI was awarded an NSF Pathways grant to explore museum practices for preschool dual language learners. In partnership with The Ohio State University, the *Expanding Repertoires* project had three interconnected activities:

- Convenings of museum practitioners
- Deep exploration of one city
- A national needs assessment



The Study

A **needs assessment** measures the discrepancy between *current* state and *desired* state.

This **needs assessment** worked with ASTC and ACM to survey science centers and children's museums about their perceived need and practices related to linguistic inclusiveness for preschool children.

We received...

61 usable questionnaires

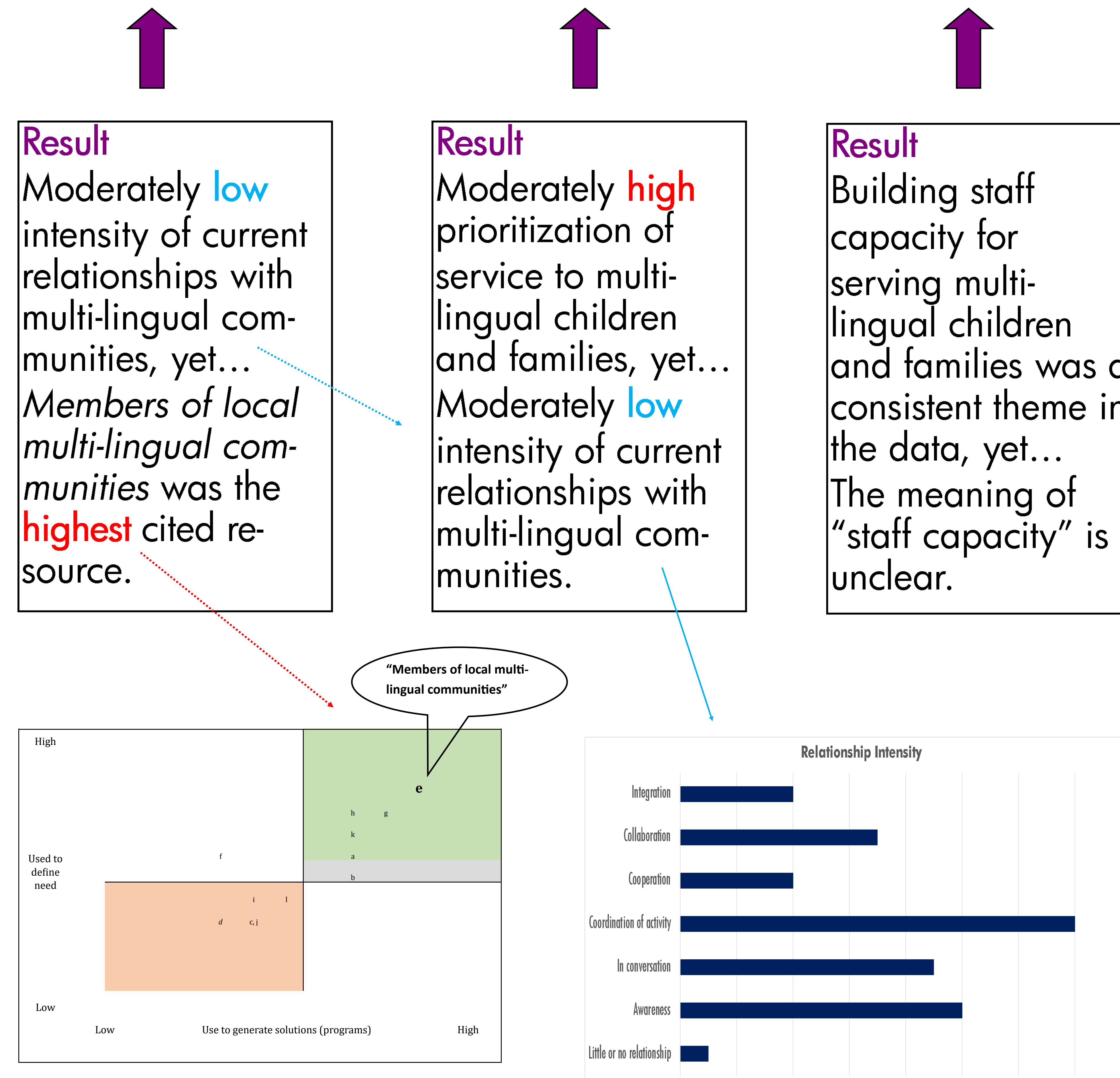
