Dear Majority Leader McConnell and Minority Leader Schumer & Madame Speaker Pelosi and Leader McCarthy:

As you evaluate funding for the resources our nation's schools will need to reopen in person this Fall and next year, the undersigned organizations urge you to give special consideration to the role outdoor spaces can play in enhancing the safety, well-being, and academic success of students and teachers. Supporting school ground improvements and programs for effective outdoor classrooms, safe play, and project-based learning could make a significant difference in the back-to-school efforts of public K-12 school districts nationwide. We urge you to consider school ground improvements in any shorter term funding for schools and in funding support for longer term renovations and new school construction.

The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) guidelines for reopening schools during the pandemic emphasize the importance of getting children of all ages back to school for a range of reasons, including support for sustained academic achievement, stress reduction, food security, and more. Among the recommendations provided by the AAP for every age group—use outdoor spaces as much as possible.

The average primary school sits on five or more acres, while the average secondary school occupies 15 to 20 acres. And yet very few of the 100,000 public K-12 school in the U.S. fully utilize outdoor space for learning. Effective use of outdoor spaces may ultimately permit more students to attend school more days per week. Moreover, research increasingly shows significant benefits of outdoor learning on mental and physical health, stress reduction, student engagement and academic success.

The North American Association for Environmental Education recently developed <u>guidance</u> to help schools think about creative and more nature-based use of schoolyards and outdoor spaces as they plan for safe reopening during the coming school year. Opportunities to use outdoor spaces will vary in different parts of the country, for different age groups, and during different parts of the year. Green Schoolyards America has outlined several <u>site planning considerations and scenarios</u>. With proper resources, some of the steps that schools can take include:

- Taking a full inventory of outdoor locations where chairs, tables, benches etc. can be assembled in coherent learning spaces.
- Using vegetated areas, such as under trees, next to gardens and clustered landscaping to create reduced-stress environments, shade and modest screening and separation between classes.
- Erecting low cost open-sided tents to create additional weather appropriate classroom spaces in schoolyards.
- Providing outdoor opportunities for hands-on natural science investigations, community service projects, and authentic project-based STEM education.

Partnering with community-based environmental education and other nonformal program providers who
can increase a school's capacity to engage students in outdoor learning and serve as advisors for
effective use of the schoolgrounds for learning.

Funding that supports the well-planned and effective use of outdoor school spaces for learning and disease prevention and management would provide major assistance to parents and educators as they rise to meet the many challenges presented by the pandemic. This will be particularly important, in the shorter run, for addressing inequities in lower income schools where cramped indoor conditions are often not very good for appropriate social distancing and could bring disproportionate harm to families and communities those schools serve.

We recognize that state and local education agencies face enormous challenges and differing timelines, based on available public health data and local guidelines, as they plan for the 2020-2021 school year and beyond. Investments in creative approaches to using the outdoors can help to address some of those challenges and potentially pave the way for an eventual return to school that is not only safer, but contributes to a vastly more healthy and meaningful education.
